In exercise of Powers conferred by section-14 &78 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 (53 of 2005), the Governor of Bihar is pleased to make the following Rules to amend the Disaster Management (Term of Office and Conditions of Service of Members of the State Authority and Pay and Allowances to Members of Advisory Committee) Rules, 2008:-

1. Short title, extent and commencement :-

(1) These rules may be called Disaster Management (Term of Office and Conditions of Services of Members of the State Authority and Pay and Allowances to Members of Advisory Committee) (Amendments) Rules -2011.

(2) It shall come into force at once:

Provided that in case of existing vice chairman and members of the authority, it shall be deemed to be come into force from their dates of assuming their posts.

2. The sub-rule (v) of rule 4 of the Disaster Management (Term of Office and Condition of Service of Members of the State Authority and Pay and Allowances to Members of Advisory Committee) Rules, 2008 shall be substituted by the following:-

"(v)(a) A person nominated as the Vice-Chairman of the State Authority shall exercise his option to choose either :-

(i) pay (less pension in case of a retired officer), dearness allowance, House Rent Allowance, (in case Govt. accommodation is not available), medical facilities, travelling allowance, leave travel concession as admissible to the officers of Chief Secretary level in the Government of Bihar and leave as admissible to a Government servant under the All India Services (Leave) Rules 1955;

or,

(ii) Pay, daily allowance as admissible to a Cabinet Minister in the Government of Bihar, and pension (without dearness relief in case of Vice-Chairman who is a retired officer), accommodation, medical facilities and travelling allowance as admissible to a Cabinet Minister of the Government of Bihar in accordance with the Ministers of Bihar (Pay & Allowances) Rules 2006 as amended from time to time.
