**Re-Advertisement for Employment of Officers on Contract/deputation
Basis In
State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), Bihar**

(Open to Retired Commissioned Officers of Army / Navy and officers of equivalent rank working in Bihar Military Police/Bihar Home Guards, Special Battalion/ Central Para Military Forces)

(Note: Candidates who has already applied for any of these posts of officers against advertisement no. 2947(Disaster)10-11 published on 26.06.2010 need not apply again)

1. Govt. of Bihar has sanctioned a new Battalion of State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) whose main objective is to provide rescue and relief operations during natural calamities like floods, earthquakes, fire, cyclones etc. The battalion would be raised on the pattern of National Disaster Response Force. The officers and men of SDRF would be taken on contract basis from amongst retired commissioned officers of Army / Navy and on deputation basis from amongst serving officers working in Bihar Military Police/Bihar Home Guards, Special Battalion/ Central Para Military Forces. Those selected would be appointed on contract/deputation basis, initially for 3 years, extendable by another 2 years based on their competence and conduct.
2. Those appointed on contract shall be entitled to receive consolidated monthly remuneration as mentioned in this advertisement. However, the pay and allowances of those taken on deputation shall be such as applicable in the Government of Bihar in such matters.
3. Applications are invited, in the prescribed proforma, from the interested Indian Citizens who are retired Commissioned Officers of the Army/ Navy and/or serving officers working in Bihar Military Police/Bihar Home Guards, Special Battalion/ Central Para Military Forces for appointment to the following posts on the basis of contract/deputation, as the case may be.
4. **The age of the applicants should not be more than 55 (fifty five) years as on 1st August, 2010. In addition they should be physically fit for hard field duties.**

6. **Selection Procedure:**

- a) Interview at Patna before a high level Selection Committee headed by DG (Civil Defence);
- b) Physical Fitness examination by a Medical Board;
- c) Verification of documents;
- d) Police Verification.

7. **Last date of Submission of Applications:**

The candidates should submit their Applications in prescribed format along with the documents listed below by Registered post to the following address:

The applications should reach the addressee within 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in the 'Employment News' (45 days in respect of candidates belonging to far flung areas of Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and North Eastern States).

8. **Documents to be enclosed with the Application Form:**

- a) Attested copy of Matriculation or equivalent certificate as proof of age.
- b) Attested copy of educational qualifications, technical qualifications and experience certificates.
- c) Attested copy of Certificates of Awards, Medals etc.
- d) Attested copy of Caste Certificate signed/countersigned by the District Magistrate / Deputy Commissioner in case of SC/MBC//BC candidates.
- e) Two recent passport size self attested photographs (one to be pasted and the other stapled on the application form).
- f) Two self addressed envelopes with postage stamps worth Rs.25 each affixed thereon.

9. **General Instructions:**

- a) The application form must be filled up by the candidate in his own handwriting.

- b) **Those applying for employment on deputation basis should submit their application through proper channel. While forwarding the application the Competent Authority should specifically mention that if the applicant is selected, he shall be relieved forthwith for joining his post. However, the applicant may submit an advance copy of the application.**
- c) The envelope containing the application form should be superscribed **“Application for the Post of ----- in SDRF”**.
- d) No application will be accepted after the closing date;
- e) All eligible candidates will be communicated through registered post for appearing in Interview etc.
- f) Candidates are required to produce all original certificates during the Interview.
- g) The candidates called for interview etc. will not be paid any TA/DA.
- h) The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final in all respects.
- i) The selected candidates will have to undergo Basic Training in Disaster Response at any place in India, both after joining and during service. The services of candidates who fail to complete the training successfully are liable to be terminated.
- j) Selected candidates shall be liable to serve anywhere in Bihar or outside.

- m) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.

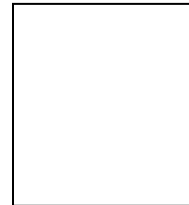
